*poster guidelines:*

“Choose one of the ideas that resulted from the brainstorming. Why is this idea the best?

Make a poster:

- The poster should explain only the final idea/ concept
- Give the concept a name (title of the poster)
- in the center of attention place big a drawing or collage, diagram... to explain your concept
- add only a few (the most important) words to explain concept (information/ interest)
- think about how to present: we want in the presentation to hear about the brainstorming and the final concept, why did you choose the final concept over the other ideas for brainstorming, poster and preparing the presentation you have 50min, so around 7.55/ 8 you should start with making the final poster.]
