These reports in turn will help spark conversations.

Reporting

Women can quickly and anonymously report their case. To suit India's multicultural, literate and illiterate audience, the panel supports multiple languages and contains both text and semi-abstracted images, supported by an audio layer.









Feedback

The data will flow into a repository, transparent to all. From here, institutions and the general audience will receive feedback, via reports and visualizations on a public screen.
